What is Totus Tuus?

The Mission and Method

Totus Tuus is a summer Catholic youth program dedicated to sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic faith. Totus Tuus assists parents and parishes by supplementing the work they are already doing.

The mission of Totus Tuus is to help the youth served *and* missionaries develop their relationship with Christ and His Church for lifelong discipleship.

Totus Tuus is concerned not only with teaching the faith, but also igniting the hearts of the team members and young people. The result has been the formation of disciples who continue to dedicate themselves to the Church.

Additionally, the daily schedule of the missionary revolves around Holy Mass, the Sacraments, and prayer. A summer given entirely to God and to the young people of this diocese would not be possible otherwise.

The Pillars

Simple Focus for Fruitful Ministry

Eucharist

Everything that occurs in a week of Totus Tuus is centered on the Eucharist. Each day and with each lesson, the missionaries desire to bring every young person into a relationship with Jesus. This aim points each to encounter Christ present at Mass.

Marian Devotion

Totus Tuus missionaries spend a week leading young people to Christ, but Mary will lead them to her Son every day. A rich relationship with Our Lady is an essential part of Totus Tuus and life of every Catholic.

Catechesis

Totus Tuus presents “Kerygmatic Catechesis” where infused in every aspect of the program is an invitation to conversion. Authentic and orthodox teaching is shared and ordered to forming disciples.

Vocational Discernment

First and foremost, missionaries share how and why to pray. Youth are invited to listen to God’s voice in their life and courageously answer His call.

Missionaries are a witness to this response as they are actively discerning their vocations.

Fun

More than just entertainment, Totus Tuus is a joyful encounter with the Lord. Missionaries are an example of the “lived Gospel”. Each young person is able to be themselves and enjoy games, skits, songs, lessons, stories, a water fight and more.

Evangelization and Catechesis

The Method

What is a "Kerygmatic Catechesis"?



Evangelization is the proclamation of salvation in Jesus Christ, in order to reconcile man with God

Evangelization aims to convert man, his culture, and the culture as a whole

Evangelization consists in the implantation of the Church; the culmination which is the Eucharist

One who evangelizes will desire a deep catechesis of self and neighbor



Catechesis is the totality of the Church's efforts to make disciples and educate them in the faith

Catechesis is an essential moment in the process of evangelization

Catechesis is systematic and must continually share the Kerygma; to bring man into the fullness of life in the Church

A catechized Christian in turn will evangelize having matured in the faith

Totus Tuus follows an "Ecclesial Method", placing catechesis and evangelization within the vision of the Church's life.

Pay

Each missionary is paid \$2,250 for the summer. Training and summer retreats are provided. Missionaries share a car and are provided housing and most meals throughout summer.

Qualities of a Totus Tuus Missionary

1. Humility

Do you put the needs of others before your own, particularly teammates and youth? I am open to fraternal correction or am I “coachable”? I understand that God comes first, others second and myself last.

2. Generous and Joyful

Be generous with your time, effort, and self. Are you giving your all to God? Hospitality goes far beyond the simple acts and can make so much of a difference. Joy brings peace and opens the door to faith.

3. Authentic

Do you know who you are in light of Christ? With peers or the youth, do you share this true self – with all your gifts and shortcomings? Can you love as Christ and forgive too? Missionaries are witnesses of faith because they are seeking to be who God made them to be.

4. Adaptable

There is a lot that goes on in a week, even a day, of Totus Tuus. Are you flexible and charitable when it comes to change? A missionary prepares well, but anticipates and can quickly adapt to change when it arrives.
